**The Melton Mowbray Building Society was incorporated in 1875 as a mutual building society for the benefit of the people of Melton Mowbray and the surrounding area.**

**The primary purpose of the Society remains to provide saving schemes, mortgage finance, personal finance advice to its members.**

**The Society has 4 local branches and 8 agency offices.**

The Melton began working with Newcastle Building Society in 1997, at this time they were looking for a reliable supplier who would provide compliance systems, that would be updated in line with legislative and regulatory changes. The Melton found that the screens were similar and this was felt would ease the integration. The service needed to be something that would work for both parties so both societies worked together to ensure that the system could function at a high level. The entire service includes the out of hours processing facilities and hardware management. In May 2007 The Melton migrated their disaster recovery and platform hosting onto the Newcastle's AS400 Systems.
